Questions to Ask

- Is listening level higher than reading level? If so... consider a Reading Accommodation—
 Text Reader, Audio,
 Human Reader and
 Digital Text
- Is listening level relatively the same as reading level?
 Look further to identify if audio or video supports student's attention, motivation, independence etc..
- Is listening level below reading level?
 Consider alternate material written with language at students' reading level.
