Questions to Ask

? *Is listening level higher than reading level? If so... consider a Reading Accommodation—Text Reader, Audio, Human Reader and Digital Text*

? *Is listening level relatively the same as reading level? Look further to identify if audio or video supports student's attention, motivation, independence etc..*

? *Is listening level below reading level? Consider alternate material written with language at students' reading level.*
